License Agreement

The access to and the use of the online form of the Publications of Thieme Medical Publishers, Inc., and Georg Thieme Verlag, Stuttgart (hereinafter: Thieme-connect) is governed by the following General Terms:

1. License

Thieme Medical Publishers, Inc., 333 Seventh Ave., NY 10001, NY (hereinafter: the Publisher) hereby grants to you (hereinafter: the User) the non-exclusive and non-transferable right and license to access, retrieve, display and make copies from those publications at Thieme-connect, for which an individual subscription has been paid, solely for personal use in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. Use of the online Publications constitutes User's agreement with these terms.

2. User ID and Password

User may select a User ID and a password (hereinafter: personal access data) of his own choice. These personal access data are for User's personal use only. The personal access data may not be passed on to third parties. User is responsible for every session on Thieme-connect via his personal access data.

In case of the suspicion of any misuse of personal access data Publisher may close the involved access to Thieme-connect and may terminate this agreement without notice.

3. Copying; Transmission User may retrieve, display, download and print out copies of individual articles or other items from the online form of the Publications. Such copying shall be limited to making single copies of a reasonable number of individual items.

Publisher warrants that it is the owner of the exclusive copyright in the licensed material or that it has been granted the right to enter into this agreement on behalf of the copyright holder. The



User acknowledges and agrees that the licensed material under this agreement is copyright protected and that the exclusive copyright to the licensed material shall remain with the listed copyright holders.

4. Usage Restrictions

The online version of the Publications may not be used for any (i) specific or systematic supply or distribution of portions of, or items from, the online version of the Publications in any form to anyone whether or not such service is done for compensation, or (ii) any similar commercial or marketing activity. Single copies of the electronic version of articles can be printed out and the print copies may be used by User for personal use only.

5. Alteration, Notices

User may not modify, adapt, transform, translate or create any derivative work based on any materials included in the Publications, or otherwise use any such materials, in a manner that would infringe the copyright therein.
