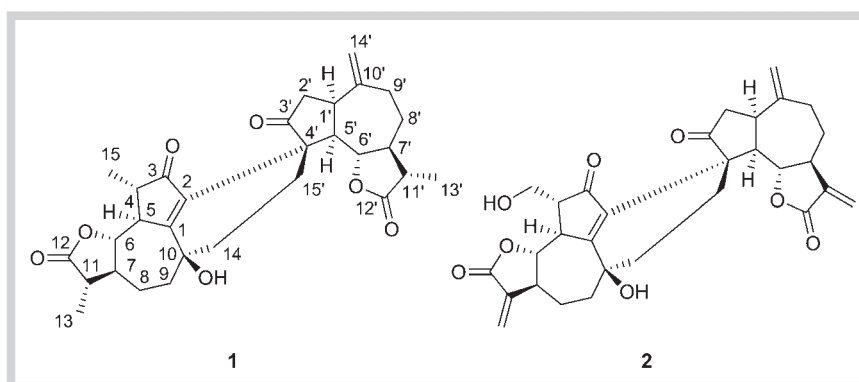

In the structures of compounds **1** and **2**, the relative configurations of 10-OH were re-assigned to be β -oriented based on the re-examination of their single crystal X-ray diffraction data (● Fig. 1). Compound **2** was re-identified as a known compound ainsliadimer B [1].
